



Mexico Unlocked: From the Capital to the Coast

Ten days through Mexico City, Puebla, Oaxaca and Zipolite — private access, local voices, and a group that feels like yours from day one.

Mexico City · Puebla (day stop) · Oaxaca · Zipolite

Departures: 6–15 February 2027 · 27 February – 8 March 2027

Mexico doesn't reveal itself in one register. It moves — from the noise and grandeur of the capital, through the colonial weight of Puebla, south into Oaxaca's valleys where Zapotec communities have been weaving, distilling and carving for centuries, and finally down to the wild Pacific at Zipolite, where the clocks stop entirely. Four nights in the capital, three in Oaxaca, two on one of Mexico's last truly free-spirited beaches. What makes it ours is who we hand the day to: a chinampa collective still farming the canals the Aztecs cut, a Zapotec guide interpreting his own ancestors' city, and twenty-five families running a mangrove reserve they restored themselves.

Day by day

DAYS 1-4: MEXICO CITY

Day 1 Arrival, Colonia Roma check-in; orientation walk with the Lead Explorer; welcome dinner at a celebrated neighbourhood cantina.

Day 2 Historic Centre with a private guide — Zócalo, Templo Mayor, the Palacio Nacional murals; free afternoon and evening.

Day 3 Xochimilco with a community chinampa collective — canoe through the quiet canals to a working farm, a meal from what grows there, axolotl conservation; free afternoon.

Day 4 Private Teotihuacán excursion, out early; free afternoon and evening.

DAYS 5-7: PUEBLA & THE OAXACA VALLEYS

Day 5 Road south via Puebla — Zócalo, Capilla del Rosario, mole tasting, El Parián — arriving Oaxaca in the evening.

Day 6 Mitla with a Zapotec guide from the community, then Hierve el Agua; free evening.

Day 7 Oaxaca market immersion with a culinary specialist; free afternoon and evening.

DAYS 8-10: ZIPOLITE & THE PACIFIC COAST

Day 8 Over the sierra to Zipolite — clothing-optional, quietly LGBTQ+ welcoming; sunset on the beach, free evening.

Day 9 La Ventanilla community lagoon reserve — mangrove boat, crocodiles in habitat, reforestation led by the families who run it; free afternoon; farewell dinner.

Day 10 Departure — private transfers to Huatulco airport or Puerto Escondido airport.
